LOCATING SALES BOARDS IN THE PARISH

Prior to 2005, Councillors adopted a policy that restricted the positioning of 'Sales Boards' for properties being marketed in the Parish.

Existing legislation restricts the installation of a 'For Sale' sign at any location other than at the property being offered for sale. Councillors agreed that the erection of a 'For Sale' sign would only be accepted at the property itself and that any organisation which allows a sales board to be erected in a grass verge, highway or in a field adjacent to the highway would be asked to remove the sign. Where the organisation fails to remove an illegal sign when requested, a formal complaint will be made to either the District Council (lack of Planning Consent) or Highway Authority (Highway legislation), to use their legal powers to remove the offending signage in the interest of Safety.
