4. Matters Arising from the Update Notes for June 2021

4.1 Highway Issues

The Chairman and Clerk met the Highway maintenance Manager from Area 6 on site, to review alternative ways to eliminate flooding on the footpath adjacent to the B1224. A member of the Consultants employed by Area 6 attended the meeting and a representative from Highfields Tom Cat Lane Bickerton appeared briefly.

Budget figures will now be produced by Area 6 for alternative schemes for the remediation works.

Area 6 Engineers are now aware of a long standing issue along the B1224, where Highway gulleys do not discharge into the limited number of water courses that exist. A major capital expenditure scheme may have to be considered to correct the long standing design problem in the future.
